**Important! Please give the name of the participant and the cause of transfer,( e.g. Peter Meier, EM U8m). Payment by cash at the competition place is not possible.**

**Costs:** Accommodation takes place in rooms with 4 beds. There are only a few rooms with 2 beds available. This rooms are given away in order to the entry. Costs of accommodation, food, travel, fare and entry fee have to be paid by the participants or the clubs themselves. The participants can choose to bring their own bed linen with them or to borrow it for the price of 3,50 Euro from the Kinder- und Erholungszentrum (place of accommodation).

per adult:

in 4-bed-rooms **135,00 €**accommodation/food

**How to find it/ by car:**

1<sup>st</sup> possibility: motorway A4 till Dresden, exit Hellerau. Then use the B6 towards Bischofswerda, till Fischbacher Kreuz (roundabout), then direction Stolpen, Neustadt to Sebnitz.

2<sup>nd</sup> possibility: motorway A4 till exit Burkau. Then towards Bischofswerda, Neustadt, Sebnitz.

In Sebnitz till **border crossing point Sebnitz**, then exactly **in front of that turn off to the right**, this street goes to the Kinder- und Erholungszentrum and is also signposted from the Amusement Park.
